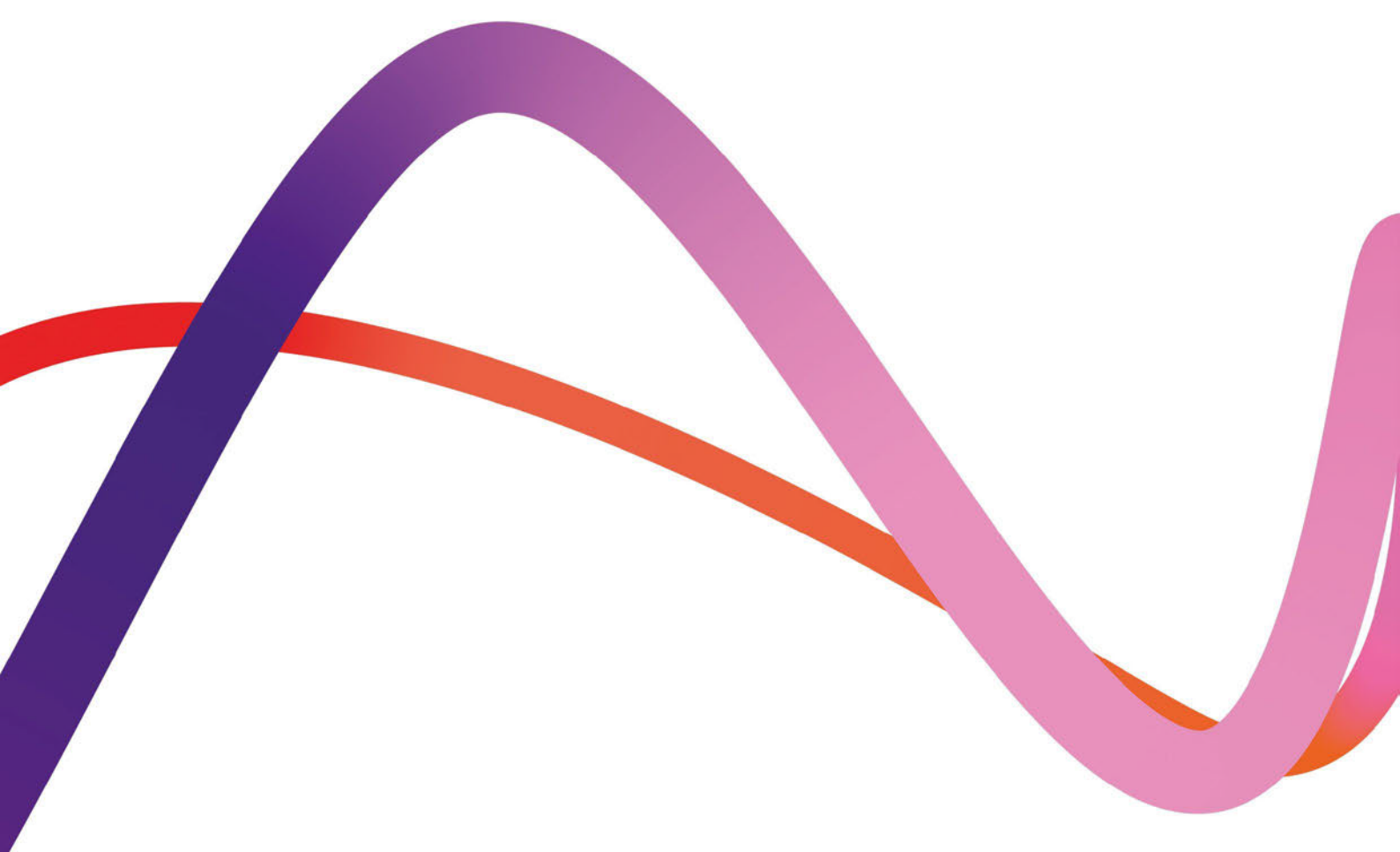

The Proposed Development as described in Schedule 1 of the Draft DCO is an NSIP as it includes development within the categories in s(14) of the Planning Act 2008. The development satisfies s14(1) and s15 of the Planning Act 2008 as it is for the construction of an onshore generating station in England, and it has a capacity of more than 50 megawatts.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development

* Brief non-technical description of the Proposed Development

The Proposed Development comprises an Energy from Waste (EfW) Combined Heat and Power (CHP) Facility together with associated Grid Connection, CHP Connection, Water Connections, Access Improvements and Temporary Construction Compound (TCC).

The Proposed Development would recover useful energy in the form of electricity and steam from up to 625,000 million tonnes of non-recyclable (residual), non-hazardous municipal, commercial and industrial waste each year. The Proposed Development has a generating capacity of over 50 megawatts and the electricity would be exported to the grid. The Proposed Development would also have the capability to export steam and electricity to users on the surrounding industrial estate.

Further details of the Proposed Development are provided in Environmental Statement Chapter 3: Description of the Proposed Development (Volume 6.2).

The EfW CHP Facility would be located on the industrial estate, Algores Way, Wisbech, within the administrative boundary of Cambridgeshire County Council. It is centred at National Grid Reference TF 45564 07955. The Grid Connection would run from the EfW CHP Facility north-east to the Walsoken substation within the administrative boundary of Norfolk County Council. The site location is illustrated on the Site Location Plan (Volume 2.1).
