Application by Medworth CHP Limited for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Medworth Energy from Waste Combined Heat and Power Facility.

This is a response from Suffolk County Council to your email communication of Adequacy of consultation request 2022 regarding the above.

Having regard to Sections 42, 47 and 48 of the Planning Act 2008, we are of the view that Medworth CHP Limited have carried out adequate pre-application consultation in accordance with the provisions as set out in Sections 42, 47 and 48 of the Act.

Engagement commenced from Scottish Power Renewables on 3rd of December 2019 (submission of Scoping Report to SoS).

Section 42 of the Planning Act 2008 outlines that the applicant must consult each local authority that is within Section 43. It is noted that Suffolk County Council are not a host authority but have been consulted at all relevant stages.

Medworth CHP Ltd produced a Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC), in accordance with Section 47 of the Planning Act 2008. The SoCC was published in June 2021.
