Thank you for consulting North Norfolk District Council regarding the Rule 8 letter for the Medworth Energy from Waste Combined Heat and Power Facility.

NNDC have no comments or observations to make on this NSIP and have no plans to dedicate available resource to review and take part in the NSIP examination. This is because the location of the proposed energy from waste site and the distance from the boundary of North Norfolk District Council's (NNDC) area, means that the only likely potential impacts arise from emissions to air from the plant and from highway matters. Given that emissions to air are highly regulated and on the basis that any highway related matters will be considered by Norfolk County Council as Highway Authority for the NNDC area, NNDC do not consider it necessary or appropriate to participate in the NSIP and would ask the Inspectorate to note this request.


