Dear Inspectorate,

We are one of the leading manufacturers of fresh apple products in the UK, supplying major retailers and brands. Our first factory located in Wisbech opened in 1994 and we moved to our purpose-built facility on Algores way in 2008 employing 30 people year round.

I am objecting to the proposed incinerator plans due to the following reasons;

1. We produce and deliver fresh apple products with a short shelf life to our customers so any closures or obstructions to Algores way will have a significant impact on our business. We require access to our site 24/7 360 days of the year. This point is concerning the propose compulsory purchase of algores way, proposed works located directly outside our front gate for water and access improvements.
2. Any disruption to our water/electrical supply will halt our production causing significant losses financially and reputationally to our business. We deal with large bakeries and supermarkets which have short patients for delays and orders not being fulfilled.
3. Our business and subsequent employment of Wisbech residence will come under pressure due to our customers have reservations to the impact and potential contamination of our fresh products being grown locally and then manufactured within 100m of an incinerator.
4. Our own farm is located 6km from the proposed site and we source from many other farmers in the locality. It is very concerning to producing a food product which will then be going around the entire nation with potentially higher levels of contaminants damaging the health of members of the public.

I am very concerned that this development will destroy the years of hard work that have gone into developing our site and contributing positively for our community. It cannot be of any benefit to this town and will only serve to remove employment opportunities, I will certainly not be able to plan further development and expansion in our site if this proposal goes ahead.
