This letter sets out Medworth CHP Limited's ('the Applicant') response to the Examining Authority's (ExA) request for submissions at Deadline 2 as set out in the Rule 8 letter issued by the ExA on 2nd March 2023.

As explained in our covering letter dated 10 March 2023 submitted at Deadline 1 [REP1-001], we had intended to update the draft SoCG with Wisbech Town Council (Volume 9.6) at Deadline 2. However, Wisbech Town Council has declined to comment on the draft SoCG until it has had the opportunity to review the Applicant's updated Waste Fuel Availability Assessment (Volume 7.3) [APP-094] which has now been submitted at Deadline 2. The Applicant will therefore continue to engage with Wisbech Town Council with a view to submitting an updated SoCG at Deadline 3.

The Applicant received comments from the Host Authorities on the draft SoCG at Deadline 1 (Volume 9.5) [REP1-038] shortly before Deadline 2. The Applicant intends to review these comments and engage with the Host Authorities regarding any updates with a view of submitting an updated SoCG at Deadline 3.

Environmental Permit Update

Issued on the 15 March 2023, the Applicant responded to a request for further information to duly make the Environmental Permit application on 23 March 2023. The Applicant currently waits for the completion of the Environment Agency's duly made checks A further update will be provided at Deadline 3.
