Firstly I would like to thank the Secretary of State for giving both myself, and my fellow residents of Wisbech and the surrounding areas one final opportunity to comment on the application by Medworth CHP Ltd to build an incinerator in my home town.

My position has not changed since my original comments, I still believe the application should be rejected.

My reasons for believing Wisbech is NOT a suitable site for this project are manifestly many, so I will only bullet point a brief handful of what I see as the most important aspects, as follows –

Proximity to a school

Endangered species on the proposed site

Vastly inadequate road network

Job losses as key employers relocate away from the area

Opposition from key local businesses

Opposition from local council

Opposition from local residents

Health concerns

Environmental concerns as to waste incineration

Proximity of other approved incinerators in Boston and Peterborough

I could go on but I am sure my fellow residents can speak much more eloquently on the myriad of reasons as to why this proposal should be rejected. In short however, I hope it has been clearly shown that Wisbech is simply not equipped to engage with a project of this size without serious ramifications, and I hope the Secretary of State is minded of the will of the people when making the final decision.
