I should like to add to the Wisbech Town Council reply including “Wisbech Roads will be heavily affected. An Incinerator of the size proposed would create hundreds of additional large lorry journeys daily creating significant additional congestion and wear and tear on already busy roads.”

We only have single carriageway roads around Wisbech and roundabouts on the bypass which are already tailed-back, even in the winter, let alone the summer holiday traffic to the coast times. The roads around here are awful – especially on the proposed industrial estate areas Algores Way and Boleness Road where we have had staff and company vehicles damaged already.

I have actually had a vehicle crash into mine when I was entering our factory premises as it was going too fast to stop!

The massive lorries always speed past our gate.

They also park at the roadside creating chaos for people going to the recycling centre on Boleness Road.

Safety is paramount and this proposed development will significantly create more dangerous conditions – even deaths – so on your head be it.

Nothing is worth that – REFUSE IT.
