I **Object** to the proposed Wisbech Medworth Energy from waste combined heat and power facility (Incinerator)

With regard to my previous complaint that I was not made aware of the scheme for the proposed wisbech incinerator

Like I said I was aware like many of the incinerator being proposed to be built in wisbech, Cambridgeshire, Norfolk border ,after previously being rejected by Norfolk council.

However I do not read newspapers or listing or watch the news, I was presuming at some point, that every house within a certain radius would have been sent a letter or form by post.

Something of which I never received, nor did any one I have spoke to even people less than 1/2 mile from the proposed site

I think its ridiculous to propose such a building in an already congested town, looking at the book of reference you have sent to me via email, I could not believe the amount of land which is needed to be purchased and the all the disruptions to water, gas, sewers, electricity, roads, and communications.

This is going to cause such major problems to the surrounding communities and probably the busiest road in the region the A47, especially as this is the main holiday route for the whole of Norfolk.

The fact also that Norfolk council had already rejected this being built in their county and yet, its now proposed on the Cambridgeshire / Norfolk border, With the electricity its generating being fed to the grid in NORFOLK and not Cambridgeshire

Why this cannot be built in a less populated area and closer to the grid its supplying, rather than disturbing so much arable land and the associated wildlife which lives in the area, And there is a lot of deer, brown squirrels, and obviously bees and other insects

I have also been heard that several major firms currently in wisbech especially Purina pets and other food companies, will no longer stay in wisbech if this goes ahead, this will lead to major unemployed in the town.

I live less than 2 miles from the site and feel the company should have the legal obligation to send a letter to every household in the surrounding area, something

like I said was never done
