To whom it may concern.

My main objections to the incinerator planned for Wisbech are:

Wisbech roads cannot cope with more lorries. 300 lorries or more will make pollution worse. When roads are closed due to roadworks or accidents country lanes which are unsuitable for lorries will be used wrecking roads which are already in a poor state and making villages more dangerous to live in.

Food factories having to move because Wisbech no longer meets their health standards will bring major job losses and there will be very few factories interested in their electricity or steam if any. This mega incinerator will be an eyesore polluting our air and is so very close to Wisbech Town centre schools and housing.

The fact it is to be built on a flood plane makes it extremely detrimental and vulnerable to both tidal and groundwater flooding especially due to the areas wetland nature for much of the holocene coupled with potential rises in relative global sea level.
