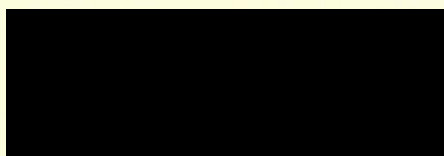
You will shortly be making the decision on 21st February about the above NSIP which would, if approved, be in my constituency.
