I hereby certify that, in compliance with the requirements under regulation 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 –

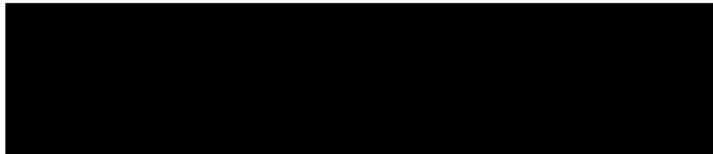
- (a) notice of the application was given to the persons identified under regulation 11;

In relation to the application for an order to grant development consent for the construction, operation, maintenance and decommissioning of an offshore wind farm (known as Awel y Môr Offshore Wind Farm), located approximately 10 kilometres off the coast of North Wales in the Irish Sea; including up to 50 wind turbine generators and associated infrastructure making landfall at Ffrith Beach, east of Rhyl, and in the County of Denbighshire, the installation of underground cables and the construction of an electrical substation and associated infrastructure in order to connect the development to the National Grid's existing substation at Bodelwyddan.
