Examining Authority's Note of an Unaccompanied Site Inspection (USI)

Inspection 4: Environs of existing offshore wind farm substation (onshore) locations and infrastructure in Suffolk, England – 14 and 15 November 2022


This note is a brief record to inform the Applicant, Interested Parties and any other parties of the actions taken by the Examining Authority (ExA). The ExA undertook USIs on Monday 14 and Tuesday 15 November 2022. The inspections took place on foot, from public roads and public rights of way (PRoW). The routes were planned having regard to the location of existing onshore substations. The purpose of the USIs was to enable the ExA to obtain views of, and to become familiar with, existing onshore substation infrastructure and associated environs.

The ExA (or a combination of its members) may undertake further USIs in due course when and where necessary.

## Day 1 - Monday 14 November 2022

Weather: Clear Visibility: Good

The inspection was attended by the full ExA. The ExA parked at Sizewell beach car park and walked from the car park, along Sizewell Gap and Sandy Lane to the Greater Gabbard and Galloper onshore substations and associated infrastructure and viewed the surrounding environs. The ExA also walked further along Sizewell Gap, in the direction of Leiston, to experience views of the infrastructure and wider environs.




## Day 2 - Tuesday 15 November 2022

Weather: Light cloud cover and heavy rain.

Visibility: Good

The inspection was attended by the full ExA. The ExA travelled to Bullen Lane, Bramford and parked in a layby on Bullen Lane. The ExA followed the route highlighted below via public footpaths and viewed East Anglia One, East Anglia Three (under construction) and National Grid substations, associated infrastructure and surrounding environs.
