
1 PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

1.1 This is a joint statement between Awel y Môr Offshore Wind Farm Limited (the Applicant), and SP Energy Networks (SPEN) in relation to the Awel y Môr Offshore Wind Farm (AyM) Development Consent Order (DCO) application. It sets out the matters which have been agreed and reflects the current position between the parties.

2 MATTERS THAT ARE AGREED

- 2.1 The protective provisions in favour of SP Manweb plc which is contained in Part 4 of Schedule 9 of the draft DCO submitted at Deadline 6 (REP6-005) have been agreed between the Applicant and SPEN (who acts on behalf of SP Manweb, the licenced Distribution Network Operator for the area covered by the onshore elements of AyM).
- 2.2 There are no outstanding matters of disagreement between the parties and SPEN intends to withdraw its objection to the DCO application before the close of the examination.
