Dear Sir or Madam

We write on behalf of National Grid Electricity Transmission plc (**NGET**) in relation to its objection to the Awel Y Môr Offshore Wind Farm Development Consent Order (**DCO**) being promoted by Awel Y Môr Offshore Wind Farm Limited (**Promoter**).

Whilst NGET and the Promoter have agreed principles to safeguard NGET's interests in relation to the Awel Y Môr Offshore Wind Farm Project (**Project**), the Promoter has informed NGET that the form of the draft DCO that it is submitting at Deadline 8 does not include the form of protective provisions required by NGET to protect its interests (including the safeguarding of the future extension to the Bodelwyddan substation and associated infrastructure works). As such the draft DCO does not currently reflect the principles that the Promoter has agreed with NGET.

Accordingly, NGET must continue to safeguard its position and cannot withdraw its objection at the present time. In this regard, we attach the form of protective provisions that NGET requires to be included in the DCO. It should be noted that the safeguarding provisions relating to the future substation extension at paragraphs 4 to 7 ('National Grid connection works') are based on the equivalent provisions for the protection of National Grid Carbon Limited in the recent DCO for Keadby 3, a copy of which we also enclose for completeness. NGET would be grateful if this form of protective provisions were included in any DCO granted by the Secretary of State.

I would be grateful if you could please confirm safe receipt of this submission.
