
Awel y Môr Offshore Wind Farm Development Consent Order Protective Provisions for the Welsh Ministers as Strategic Highway Authority

Further to my letter of 15 March 2023, I am writing to confirm that the attached provisions have been agreed by the Welsh Ministers, as Highway Authority for the Strategic Road Network, to ensure sufficient protection is afforded to the strategic road network in respect of the Awel y Mor Offshore Wind Farm Development Consent Order ("DCO").

It is assumed that the attached provisions will form part of the Schedule of protective provisions in the DCO (currently Schedule 9 of the draft published on the Planning Inspectorate website dated April 2022).

We appreciate that stylistic changes may be necessary for clarity and consistency purposes, however no amendments to the attached provisions should be considered agreed without the prior written consent of the Welsh Ministers.
