You may recall back in January this year that and you provided comments following our statutory consultation on the proposals for a low carbon gas-fired electricity generation station at the existing Keadby Power Station site (attached for your convenience). Thank you for very much for your inputs.

The Application for a DCO for the Keadby 3 Low Carbon Gas Fired Generating Station was accepted by PINS at the end of June 2021. All of the application documents submitted can be inspected on the Planning Inspectorate website **Constitution**). We are therefore now in the pre-examination period and are presently issuing copies of the formal notification to all consultees (and via other methods e.g. newspapers) – the legal notice can be read **Constitution**. The notice provides the deadline (2 September) for each consultee to send their representation to the Planning

Inspectorate.

In advance of the deadline, we would be pleased to discuss any matter that you raised in your previous comments, or to signpost you, if you prefer, to the relevant information. We know that the key issue you were interested in was in relation to the option to abstract water from the River Trent, if the preferred option to abstract cooling water from the Stainforth and Keadby Canal was not feasible. The following documents are therefore likely to be of most relevance to this matter:

Schedule of Other Consents and Licences Chapter 2: EIA Methodology [Construction Chapter 4: The Proposed Development Construction Chapter 12: Water Environment and Flood Risk

To summarise, the abstraction from the Canal remains the Applicant's preferred option and is subject to ongoing pre-application discussions with the Canal and River Trust and Environment Agency. However, the Applicant has also assessed the effect of the alternative abstraction option from the River Trent, which would be subject to a variation of the Keadby 1 Power Station abstraction licence if this were), if this were pursued in Chapter 12. As explained in Chapter 2, abstractions from Keadby 1 Power Station would not occur concurrently with those of the operational Proposed Development.

Please let us know if there is anything we can assist further with. We look forward to hearing from you.
