The final itinerary for the Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI) can be found below. Please read this carefully. Ordnance Survey National Grid references in the form of "(Easting, Northing)" are provided for locations in the itinerary where possible. The Applicant will ensure that copies of the itinerary and a route map are available on the day to assist those present.

Please note that the ASI is **not** an opportunity to provide any oral representations on the project or discuss evidence. It is an opportunity for the Examining Authority (ExA) to look at the physical features that can be seen on, or from, the sites. Participants may be invited by the ExA to point out specific features or sites of interest.

Joining the ASI

The deadline by which parties were asked to confirm attendance at the ASI was Monday 28 February 2022. Due to security requirements, the requirement to wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) whilst on the development site, and because capacity on the vehicles that will be used for the ASI is limited, only those who notified the ExA by Monday 28 February 2022 will be able to attend.

All attendees are asked to assemble promptly at 9:30am as the ExA will not wait for parties who are not present at the start time. Attendees will need to organise their own transport to the ASI, and parts of the ASI will require travel in attendees' own vehicles and on foot. There is an option to leave the ASI early at stage 16.

Health and safety

The Applicant will provide a health and safety briefing at the start of the ASI. Attendees will be required to wear PPE, including a hi-visibility jacket or vest, safety boots with ankle support, safety gloves and glasses, helmet, and long sleeve clothing/long trousers. Appropriate PPE will be provided by the Applicant to those who require it if this was confirmed in an attendance request by Monday 28 February 2022.

Transport arrangements

The Applicant will provide transport for parts of the ASI, however some walking and some travel in attendees' own vehicles will be necessary. For logistical and safety reasons, capacity on the transport provided by the Applicant may be limited.

Sites on private land

Access onto private land is at all times by permission of the person controlling it; landowners may refuse to allow some persons accompanying the ExA onto their land. Under those circumstances, the ExA will decide whether or not to proceed with that part of the ASI.

Refreshments

Please note refreshments will not be provided. We will stop for lunch, however all attendees are expected to provide their own lunch.

Cancellations

Please note that in the unlikely event that the ASI is cancelled, we shall endeavour to contact attendees beforehand, but we ask that you regularly check the <u>project</u> webpage of the Planning Inspectorate's National Infrastructure Planning website for any updates. We would also encourage attendees to <u>sign up for email updates</u> on the project webpage.

COVID-19 – lateral flow testing and other precautions

Attendees should consider completing a lateral flow test³ before arriving at the ASI. If you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, please do not attend.

Vehicles provided by the Applicant will be used to transport attendees during certain parts of the ASI. The use of face masks will be required on-board, as will the opening of windows to promote clean airflow.

During the ASI, all attendees are expected to follow current and relevant COVID-19 guidelines imposed by the Government and the Planning Inspectorate.

ITINERARY

While the ASI will start promptly at 10:00am, and we will endeavour to follow the timings as closely as possible, external factors such as weather and traffic may slightly affect these timings. The ExA will close the ASI at 5:15pm, or sooner if all relevant sites have been covered.

9:30am Meet at site access road off A18 (480397, 410244)

- 1. Meet at the site access road off the A18, in the 40MPH section (signposted with large blue 'Keadby 2' signage). Refer to the enclosed directions at **Annex A**.
- 2. Signing in of all attendees.
- 3. Attendees will return to own vehicles, drive northwards along the access track to park at the vacant laydown area south of North Pilfrey Bridge at (481115, 411268).

10:00am Briefing

- 1. Welcome and briefing by the ExA.
- 2. Health and safety briefing by the Applicant.

A health and safety briefing will be provided by the Applicant at the start of the ASI. Those attending will need to comply with any reasonable requests, in addition to what is specified in this document.

 Participants will transfer into a minibus provided by the Applicant with COVID measures implemented, ie masks to be worn and windows open.

10:15am Commence the ASI

1. Mabey Bridge over Hatfield Waste Drain and A18 junction (480330, 410030)

The minibus will drive south down the road to Mabey Bridge and drop participants before picking them up.

2. North Pilfrey Bridge (481150, 411410)

10:40am The minibus will travel up the access road and cross over North Pilfrey Bridge before parking safely. Participants will walk to North Pilfrey Bridge.

3. Bonnyhale Road (480370, 411200)

10:50am Participants will walk west along Bonnyhale Road until reaching (480370, 411200) before returning to minibus.

	4. Ash Mound (481690, 412180)
11:20am	Transfer into 4x4 vehicles provided by the Applicant with COVID measures implemented in cars, ie masks to be worn and windows open. These vehicles will take attendees onto the former ash tip.
12:25pm	5. Ealand Road (482360, 411610)
	The minibus will drive east along Ealand Road, safely parking just before the junction at (482360, 411610).
12:30pm	6. Viewpoint 2: Gate Keepers Residence, Vazon Bridge (482490, 411510)
	Walk east along Ealand Road and turn right at the junction. Continue walking south over the watercourse and railway track until reaching Viewpoint 2.
12:50pm	7. Keadby 2 water abstraction intake (482750, 411509)
	Walk back north over the railway track and watercourse and take the next right. Walk east until reaching the Keadby 2 Power Station Canal Water Abstraction Intake before returning to the minibus.
1:20pm	Viewpoint L1: Chapel Lane West, Keadby (483210, 411880)
	The minibus will turn north at junction and drive along Chapel Lane before stopping at Viewpoint L1. The minibus will then continue east along Chapel Lane, south along Trent Side, west along Trent Road before parking in the main Keadby Power Station Car Park on Trent Road (483118, 411671).
1:45pm	9. Lunch (483118, 411671)
	Attendees to have lunch in the minibus or existing cabins provided by the Applicant depending on their preference. Welfare facilities are available.
2:15pm	10. Return to minibus (483118, 411671)
	Transfer into the minibus provided by the Applicant with COVID measures implemented, ie masks to be worn and windows open.
2:20pm	11. Railway Wharf (483466, 411451)
	The minibus will take attendees along Trent Road to Railway Wharf (Waterborne Transport Offloading Area).



2:30pm	12. Locations along Trent Side, B1392 - (483510, 411620) to (483640, 412220)
	Walk north up Trent Side (B1392), taking in views of River Water Abstraction Option (Work No. 4B), Cooling Water Discharge Pipeline (Work No. 5) and Temporary Haulage Route (Work No. 10A).
2:40pm	13. Locations along Trent Side, B1392 - (483510, 411620) to (483640, 412220)
	Attendees will be picked up at (483668, 412280).
2:50pm	14. Viewpoint 4: Public Right of Way (KEAD9 and KEAD10), North of Keadby (483220, 412380)
	Attendees will be taken to Viewpoint 4.
3:00pm	15. Viewpoint 6 Trunk Road, Keadby (483210, 409770)
	The minibus will travel east, turn right and travel south along Trent Side (B1392) and A18 before turning left and parking safely on Kelsey Lane. Participants will cross the road to Viewpoint 6.
3:20pm	16. PRoW (CROW 14) south of Eastoft Road, Crowle (478393, 412754)
	The minibus will turn left back onto the A18 and drive south. There is an option to leave the ASI at this stage; if participants would like to return to their own vehicles, the minibus will drive via the parked cars.
	The minibus will then return to travel west along the road before turning right onto the A161. The minibus will drive north along the A161 until reaching the mini roundabout. At the mini roundabout the minibus will take the second exit onto Fieldside and travel north along Fieldside before turning right onto Field Road. The minibus will travel east along Field Road before parking outside an existing electrical substation. By foot, travel along the remainder of Field Road until reaching PRoW CROW 14 before returning to the minibus.
3:50pm	17. PRoW (BELT 26) (480086, 408476)
	The minibus will travel back to the A161 and turn left to travel south, continuing south on the A161 as it crosses over the A18 and turning left onto Hagg Lane before reaching the junction with the M180. The minibus will follow Hagg Lane, turning left where it forks and turning right onto Stealgoose Lane and following it south, parking around (479073, 408598). From here, 4x4s provided by the Applicant will take attendees to the Public Right of Way BELT26 for about 1km until reaching (480086, 408476) and returning to the minibus.

18. Viewpoint 11: Public Right of Way (BURT171) (486790, 417360)

The minibus will return to the A161 and turn right, traveling north before turning right onto the A18 and returning to the parked cars. Participants will transfer out of the minibus.

4:30pm

Those continuing with the ASI should travel in their own vehicles back onto the A18, travelling east, following it around the bend and as it turns right and crosses the bridge over the River Trent. Continue on the A18 until reaching the Frodingham Grand roundabout. Take the first exit. Continue along the A1077 as it curves right and go straight at the next two roundabouts, taking the second exit at both. At the third roundabout take the first exit to head north on Normanby Road (B1430). Continue along Normanby Road through the next two roundabouts, taking the second exit at both. At the third, take the first exit on to Main Street. Continue along Main Street until turning left on to Flixborough Road. Park safely on Flixborough Road and walk to Viewpoint 11 before returning to vehicles.

Alternatively, search the postcode DN15 9HD using a satellite navigation device and follow the instructions.
