

## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

### 1.1 Overview

- 1.1.1 The Rule 8 letter dated 14 December 2021 (**PD-008**) states that week commencing 11 April 2022 has been reserved for the Accompanied Site Inspection (ASI). Comments on suggested locations/ sites for the Examining Authority (ExA) to include as part of the ASI were submitted at Deadline 1 (21 December 2022) by the Applicant in their cover letter (**REP1-001**) and by the Canal and River Trust (**REP1-023**). No other Interested Parties submitted comments on suggested locations for the ASI at Deadline 1. The Applicant previously submitted a draft ASI itinerary as Appendix 1 to the Deadline 2 Submission Cover Letter dated 01 February 2022 (**REP2-001**).
- 1.1.2 The ExA issued a Rule 16 Letter dated 21 February 2022 (**PD-014**) providing notification that the ASI would take place on 12 April 2022 and an itinerary identifying a number of locations and their ordering/timing. Following discussions with the Keadby Power Station site team and the Keadby Power Station 2 site team (which is currently a construction site) the Applicant has come up with some amendments to the proposed itinerary to ensure that is practical and logistical in nature and with small adjustments to the ordering in the published itinerary but do not result in the removal of any locations in the same. Key reasons for the changes include the need to park all vehicles safely for the entire day away from trafficked routes; avoiding transiting the operational Keadby 1 and 2 power station sites for safety reasons; and minimising walking particularly along sections lacking in pavements.
- 1.1.3 These logistical changes are submitted to the ExA for consideration.

## 2.0 APPLICANT'S ACCOMPANIED SITE INSPECTION ITINERARY

### 2.1 Overview

- 2.1.1 The Applicant will provide a minibus (or other appropriate means of transport) for the ASI, but some walking will also be required.

## 2.2 Health and Safety

- 2.2.1 Keadby Power Station is an operational power station site. For the safety of themselves and others, attendees will be required at all times to comply with the Applicant's applicable site security and safety requirements, for which a briefing will be provided. Each person will be required to wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), including hi-visibility jacket or vest, safety boots with ankle support, hard hat, safety glasses, and gloves.
- 2.2.2 The above PPE can be provided by the Applicant on the day as several sets are kept on site in a range of sizes.
- 2.2.3 Long sleeve clothing/ long trousers are recommended and the site visit will go ahead in most weather conditions.
- 2.2.4 In case of an environmental, health, or safety emergency during the site visit the site emergency contact number can be used which is written on the reverse of all site passes. This connects to the security, Emergency Response Team and EHS team. The number has also been supplied to the Planning Inspectorate in the H&S proforma.
