## THE INFRASTRUCTURE PLANNING (EXAMINATION PROCEDURE) RULES 2010, RULE 8(3)

On behalf of Keadby Generation Limited ('the Applicant') I would like to request that the Examining Authority considers exercising his discretion under the above rule to vary the examination timetable in a minor respect namely the insertion of a new deadline inserted on 10<sup>th</sup> May (two weeks after Deadline 6 in the published timetable, and two weeks before Deadline 7) for certain submissions currently identified for deadline 6.

The requested modification is presented overleaf via tracked changes to the published timetable.

The rationale for this request is as follows:

- The Applicant considers that there are practical difficulties involved in submitting the 'final preferred DCO', 'final BoR' and 'Final CA/ TP schedule' at Deadline 6 as published, given that the discretion to accept the change request is unlikely to be exercised until after this date once responses to the Rule 17 letter of 13 April 2022 have been received. For example, the Proposed Development Changes entail an additional numbered work in Schedule 1 of the draft DCO and additional areas of land in certain plots in the BoR.
- Following enquiries made in early April, the earliest meeting dates we have been offered with Crown Estate's agent is 29 April 2022. In addition a meeting Canal and River Trust for tomorrow 22 April 2022 has recently been postponed at their request to the latter half of next week.
- Negotiations on certain protective provisions are continuing. With Network Rail and National Grid
  Carbon Limited PPs and comments were returned by Applicant to these parties on 20 April 2022,
  and we are continuing to enquire with Northern Powergrid. As a general point the insertion of
  deadline here could improve the prospects of incorporating the outcomes of these discussions.

The modifications are not intended to cause additional work or submissions for any party, rather, to reschedule certain existing timetabled submissions to more appropriate points. There is no alteration to the final deadline and therefore no impact on the ability to close the examination on time.
