Summary of the Position of the Canal & River Trust

(i) Withdrawal of Objection

The Trust is pleased to confirm that it has reached a voluntary agreement with the Applicant. The Trust is also satisfied with the amended wording of the protective provisions in the latest draft DCO.

The Trust therefore withdraws its objection to the application.

(ii) Protective Provisions

The Trust is satisfied with the contents of part 2 of Schedule 10 of the latest draft of the DCO submitted at deadline 6a (dated May 2022), which contains the protective provisions for the benefit of the Trust. The Trust does not have any further comments on the protective provisions.

(iii) and (iv) Status of a Side Agreement & Compulsory Acquisition/Temporary Possession of Trust Land

The Trust's concerns in relation to the compulsory acquisition of land/rights over land owned by the Trust are addressed through the voluntary agreement with the applicant discussed in section (i) above. The Trust and the Applicant have made significant progress on reaching agreement for the voluntary acquisition of land and rights by the Applicant.

The Trust and the Applicant have agreed terms for a side agreement that sets the framework for the future working relationship between the Trust and the Applicant in respect of the development.
