Planning Act 2008 (as amended) – Section 55 Application by Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm Ltd for an Order Granting Development Consent for the Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm, Adequacy of Consultation request

I am responding on behalf of Cambridgeshire County Council to your email communication of 27th March regarding the above.

Having had regard to Sections 42, 47 and 48 of the Planning Act, I am of the view that Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm Ltd has carried out adequate pre-application consultation in accordance with the provisions as set out in Sections 42, 47 and 48.
