Application by Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm Ltd for an order granting development consent for the Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm project (EN010115)

Appointment of the Examining Authority

The above application was accepted for examination on 22 April 2024. This document provides confirmation of the Examining Authority that on **7 June 2024** has been appointed by the Planning Inspectorate, on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, to examine the application.

Initial choice of Panel or single appointed person

The Planning Inspectorate has considered the government Guidance¹ which identifies criteria relevant to appointing an Examining Authority and has decided, on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, that the application should be examined by a Panel of 5 appointable persons.

Appointment of members and lead member of the Panel

The Planning Inspectorate has considered the skill sets required for the Panel members and suitability for leading the Panel and has decided on behalf of the Secretary of State under delegated powers, to appoint Grahame Gould as Lead Member of the Examining Authority and Mark Harrison, Matthew Heron, Rebecca Norman and Felicity Webber as members of the Examining Authority.
