I hereby certify that, in compliance with the requirements of regulation 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 –


- (a) notice of the application was given to the persons identified under regulation 11; and

In relation to the application for an order to grant development consent to construct, operate, maintain, and decommission an offshore wind farm known as the Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm (“the Project”), and the associated development to connect the offshore wind farm using an onshore connection from between Frinton-on-sea and Holland-on-sea to the national grid near Little Bromley, Essex. The Project is a proposed extension to the operational Galloper Offshore Wind Farm situated off the coast of Suffolk. Habitat improvement is also proposed at Alde Ore Estuary, Suffolk.

The onshore elements of the Project are located within the Tendring District Council area in Essex, and in the East Suffolk District Council area in Suffolk.
