In relation to the application for an order to grant development consent to construct,

on-sea and Holland-on-sea to the national grid near Little Bromley, Essex. The
Project is a proposed extension to the operational Galloper Offshore Wind Farm
situated off the coast of Suffolk. Habitat improvement is also proposed at Alde Ore
Estuary, Suffolk.

The onshore elements of the Project are located within the Tendring District Council
area in Essex, and in the East Suffolk District Council area in Suffolk.

The deadline date for representations to be received by the Planning Inspectorate
under section 56 was 21 June 2024.
