#### 1 INTRODUCTION

#### 1.1 THE PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

- 1.1.1 The Five Estuaries Offshore Wind Farm (hereafter referred to as VE) is the proposed extension to the operational Galloper Offshore Wind Farm. The project includes provision for the construction, operation, maintenance and decommissioning of an offshore wind farm located approximately 37 kilometres off the coast of Suffolk at its closest point in the southern North Sea; including up to 79 wind turbine generators and associated infrastructure making landfall at Sandy Point between Frinton-on-Sea and Holland-on-Sea, the installation of underground cables, and the construction of an electrical substation and associated infrastructure near to the existing Lawford Substation to the west of Little Bromley in order to connect the development to National Grid's proposed East Anglia Connection Node substation, which would be located nearby.
- 1.1.2 All onshore connection infrastructure would be located in the administrative area of Tendring District Council, within Essex County Council. VE will have an overall capacity of greater than 100 Megawatts (MW) and therefore constitutes a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP) under Section 15 (3) of the Planning Act 2008.
- 1.1.3 A full Project description is included in the Environmental Statement, in particular 6.2.1 Offshore Project Description [APP-069] and 6.3.1 Onshore Project Description [AS-004].

#### 1.2 PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

- 1.2.1 This Statement of Commonality has been prepared at the request of the Examining Authority.
- 1.2.2 This document sets out the progress of the various Statements of Common Ground (SoCG) the Applicant was requested to enter into by the Examining Authority (ExA). The topics set out in this Statement of Commonality are broader than the ones addressed in the specific SoCGs, which includes more details on the specific positions of each party.
- 1.2.3 The issues listed in this document have been taken from Relevant Representations general topics, the Environmental Statement chapters, the Project Wide chapters and supporting plans.

#### 1.3 LIST OF STATEMENTS OF COMMON GROUND

1.3.1 The Applicant was requested by the ExA to progress a Statement of Common Ground with the parties listed in the table below by the Examining Authority. The table sets out the list of parties and the status of each agreement.

- 1.3.2 As stated in 10.3 Statements of Common Ground Position Statement [PD2-002], the German Federal Maritime and Hydrographic Agency and the Ministry of Defence have stated that they are not seeking to agree a SoCG. Therefore, they have not been included in Tables 1 and 3.
- 1.3.3 Also stated in PD2-002, National Grid Electricity Transmission PLC and the Applicant have agreed that the Tripartite Position Statement with North Falls Offshore Wind Farm adequately addresses the issues between the parties and a SoCG is not being progressed. Therefore, it has not been included in Tables 1 and 3.


