1. NOTICES FOR STATUTORY PUBLICITY

1.1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1.1 North Lincolnshire Green Energy Park Limited (the Applicant) is submitting an application for a Development Consent Order (DCO) under section 37 of the Planning Act 2008 (the 2008 Act) in respect of the North Lincolnshire Green Energy Park (the Project).
- 1.1.2 The Applicant is seeking development consent for the construction and operation of a combined heat and power (CHP) enabled energy generating development, with an electrical output of up to 95 megawatts (MWe), incorporating carbon capture, associated District Heat and Private Wire networks (DHPWN), hydrogen production, ash treatment, and other associated developments for the Project on land at Flixborough Industrial Estate, situated at Stather Rd, Flixborough, Scunthorpe (the Application Land).
- 1.1.3 A DCO is required for the Project as it falls within the definition and thresholds for a 'Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project' (NSIP) being for the construction or extension of a generating station (s14(1)(a) 2008 Act) with a capacity above 50MW (s15(2) 2008 Act). The DCO, if made by the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (Secretary of State), would be known as the 'North Lincolnshire Green Energy Park Order' (the Order).
- 1.1.4 This document has been provided in support of the DCO application; it provides copies of the notices that have been published prior to the submission of the DCO application in accordance with Section 47 and Section 48 of the 2008 Act and The Infrastructure Planning (Applications: Prescribed Forms and Procedures) Regulations 2009 (APFP Regulations).
- 1.1.5 **Table 1.1** provides a list of the newspapers in which the notices have been published and the dates of publication. **Section 2** of this document provides copies of those notices.
- 1.1.6 Further information relating the pre-application publicity and consultation is provided in the Consultation Report (Document Reference 7.1).
