We write on behalf of Solar 21 Renewable Energy Limited ('the Applicant') in response to the Examining Authority's (ExA's) 'Rule 6' letter dated 18th October 2022 to confirm the position of a number of procedural matters in advance of the Preliminary Meeting.

Procedural Matters

Request for Changes to Examination Timetable

The Applicant has reviewed the draft examination timetable provided at Annex D of the Rule 6 letter and request the ExA to consider one specific change to Deadline 7 (12 April 2023).

The reason for the Applicant's request change is that Deadline 7 falls a day after team members return from the extended Easter bank holiday weekend. We request that this date be pushed back two days to the 14th April to give additional time to finalise necessary documents following these public holidays. We do not propose that any other dates in the timetable would need to change as a result of this as the following deadlines are far enough away from Deadline 7 to avoid being impacted. Importantly, we note that the requested change would not lengthen the overall examination timetable.

Blended Preliminary Meeting / Hearings

The Applicant agrees with the approach taken by the ExA that the Preliminary meeting should be carried out as both a virtual event and a physical 'in-person' event. The Applicant believes that this approach should remain the standard for this project for consistency unless specific considerations dictate that a purely virtual or physical 'in-person' meeting is required.

The Applicant is agreeable to the list of Principal Issues set out in Annex C of the Rule 6 Letter.
