Further to my e-mail below on the Preliminary Meeting (15 November), I would also like to confirm that ABP personnel from Humber Estuary Services (statutory harbour authority for the Humber Estuary) will, as requested, attend the Issue Specific Hearing on 16 November to discuss how marine operations are conducted within our statutory harbour area. 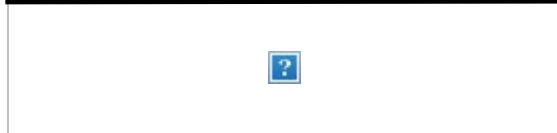
