NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, at the dates, times and locations set out below, two issue specific hearings will be held by the Examining Authority (appointed by the Secretary of State) for the examination of the application made by North Lincolnshire Green Energy Park Limited ("the Applicant") for a Development Consent Order ("the DCO") for the **North Lincolnshire Green Energy Park** ("the Application").

The Application was made to the Secretary of State (via the Planning Inspectorate) under sections 14(1)(a),15(2) and 37 of the Planning Act 2008 on 31 May 2022 and was accepted by the Planning Inspectorate for examination on 27 June 2022. The Application has been given the Planning Inspectorate reference number **EN010116**.

SUMMARY OF THE SCHEME

The Applicant seeks development consent for the North Lincolnshire Green Energy Park in Yorkshire and the Humber, located within the administrative area of North Lincolnshire Council ("the Scheme"). The Scheme would be located on land within and to the south of Flixborough Industrial Estate, to the north west of Scunthorpe, North Lincolnshire.

The main aspects of the Scheme comprise:

- An energy recovery facility (ERF), including;
 - switchyard;
 - · a water treatment facility;
 - a carbon dioxide (CO2) capture utilisation and storage (CCUS) facility;
- a bottom ash and flue gas residue handling and treatment facility (RHTF);
- a concrete block manufacturing facility (CBMF);
- a plastic recycling facility (PRF);
- a hydrogen production and storage facility;
- an electric vehicle (EV) and hydrogen (H2) re-fuelling station;
- battery storage;
- a hydrogen and natural gas above ground installation (AGI);
- a new access road and parking;
- a gatehouse and visitor centre with elevated walkway;
- railway reinstatement works including, sidings at Dragonby, reinstatement and safety improvements to the 6km private railway spur, and the construction of a new railhead with sidings south of Flixborough Wharf;
- a northern and southern district heating and private wire network (DHPWN);
- habitat creation, landscaping and ecological mitigation, including green infrastructure and 65 acre wetland area;
- new public rights of way and cycle ways including footbridges;

- Sustainable Drainage Systems (SuDS) and flood defence; and
- utility constructions and diversions.

If the DCO is made by the Secretary of State, it would allow the Applicant, for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining the Scheme, to acquire compulsorily interests in and rights over land, including the power to create and acquire new rights over land, and to take possession of and to use land temporarily.
