Proposed Accompanied Site Inspection itinerary – Friday 27 January 2023

I am writing to advise you that the itinerary for the accompanied site inspection has been finalised and can be found below.

This itinerary has been drafted taking account of suggested locations submitted by Interested Parties by Deadline 1, the Applicant's draft itinerary submitted at Deadline 2 and 3, and taking into account the unaccompanied site inspections carried out on the 21 and 22 September 2022 and 23 January 2023. Some of those locations suggested have already been visited during these unaccompanied inspections.

Please note that only the locations listed in the itinerary below will be visited during the accompanied site inspection. However, I am very grateful for all of the suggestions and I can confirm that the Examining Authority (ExA) may visit the additional locations on an unaccompanied basis during the course of the Examination. In the event that a site or part of a site is found to be unsuitable to visit on an unaccompanied basis, time is reserved, if required, for a further accompanied site inspection during the week commencing 27 March 2023.

Please note that the ExA's inspection of sites is **not** an opportunity to provide any oral representations; no discussion on the project or evidence will take place. It is solely an opportunity for the ExA to look at the physical features that can be seen on, or from the sites. Participants may be invited by the ExA to point out specific features or sites of interest.

Please note that the Applicant will supply transport for the inspection. Access to the transport to accompany the ExA will be provided on a first-come, first served basis. It is suggested that those who are not able to ride in the transport provided either arrange

their own transport, elect a representative to attend on behalf of groups or attend at a specific location rather than the visit in its entirety.

If you would like to make oral representations time is reserved, if required, for a further Open Floor Hearing during the week commencing 27 March 2023.

The site inspection will commence at 09:30am at Park Ings Grain Shed. Park Ings grain sheds are just north of the pumping station on the Stather Road. There is room to park cars at the grain sheds
