Please accept the following submission from the Environment Agency pursuant to Deadline 7.

Foul Water Drainage

The Environment Agency has considered the additional submissions made by the Applicant at Deadline 6; in particular the updated Environment Statement Chapter 3 Project Description and Alternatives [REP6-019 tracked]. This Chapter now includes section 7.13, which summarises the cross-site effluent control strategy and confirms that there will be no off-site trade effluent discharge to the water environment and all domestic effluent will discharge to the public sewer, as agreed with Severn Trent Water. We confirm that this satisfactorily resolves our outstanding concerns regarding foul water drainage for the proposed development.

Examining Authority's 2nd Written Questions

The Environment Agency was unable to answer the Examining Authority's 2nd Written Question Q2.6.0.2, at Deadline 6. However, we can now comment that carbon capture readiness, i.e. sufficient land and any known barriers, does not apply to energy from waste plants so the guidance we follow does not include them. Accordingly, we are unable to offer any assistance on these matters.
