Deadline 8 Submission comments on Volume 6 Environmental Statement 6.2.5 Air Quality.

Would the applicant like to explain why they have used British National Grid maps, as used for planning purposes, and omitted the names of both Amcotts and Flixborough from those maps on figures 4,5,6,7, and 8, pages 102 to 106 in Appendix A.

AMCOTTS in particular because of its CLOSE PROXIMITY to the proposed development will be a crucial receptor impacted by NO₂, NO_x and PM₁₀, yet has astonishingly, along Flixborough, been erased from these images.

Can the applicant explain why villages that will apparently be impacted less by the pollutants ARE shown on these same images.

How can information of such crucial importance be left out? Is it to give the general impression that we don't exist or that there are no nearby villages that will be impacted by pollutants from the proposed development?

Furthermore with reference to the same figures 4,5,6,7 and 8 pages 102 to 106 Appendix A, can the applicant explain why, as well as the two village names being omitted, they have also omitted the yellow squares indicating "Human Receptor" with regard to pollutants NO₂, NO_x and PM₁₀ in those UNIDENTIFIED village areas?

Would it not be reasonable to ask that the applicant resubmit volume 6 Environmental Statement 6.2.5 Air Quality with the appropriate corrections?

The omission of such crucial factual information is simply not acceptable!
