Statements of Common Ground

Whilst the Applicant has sought to engage with each party to progress the SoCGs as far as possible, it has not been possible in all instances to agree a final signed version. The Draft SoCG submitted at Deadline 9 with Jotun Paints stands as the most recent, as a result of the ongoing discussions between the Applicant and Stakeholder to come to an agreement.

The Statement of Commonality submitted at this deadline includes a full explanation as to status of each SoCG.

Network Rail

The Applicant and Network Rail have reached agreement on the form of protective provisions and these have been included in the updated version of the DCO which is being submitted at this Deadline in Part 5 of Schedule 14 (Protective Provisions) of the Order.

Updated Guide to Application

All new and revised documents are referenced in the enclosed updated Application Guide (Document 1.2 – Application Guide [Revision 11]). A clean and tracked version has been provided for clarity. As requested by the Examining Authority, an additional column with the examination reference has been added to the document. Where a document is new and does not yet have an examination reference TBC has been used.

Appended Letters of Support

The Applicant has secured Memoranda of Understanding for the supply of RDF in excess of the volume required by the Project and some of these waste partners have offered Letters of Support which identify some of the issues facing the waste management sector from the waste industry's point of view. 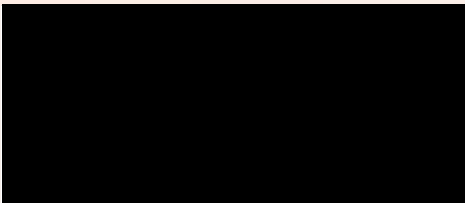
