Good morning,

Thank you for allowing Henfield Parish Council to comment on the Rampion 2 Scoping Study. Three issues concern the Henfield Parish Council:

- The site of the Bolney Substation. To reduce the impact on the environment we would prefer that the site of the new Bolney substation be as near as possible to the existing Bolney substation; to which it will have to be connected in any event. The existing Bolney Substation already has the necessary access.
- The route of the cable corridor. The Henfield Neighbourhood Plan has allocated a site for development that extends from the northern built-up area boundary of Henfield to Chess Brook and the ancient woodland of Parsonage Wood. In addition crossing this site on an east/west axis is a High Pressure Gas Main. We therefore ask Rampion 2 to note the new development and High Pressure Gas Main; and route the Cable Corridor north of the B2116 Albourne Road, and preferably north of Chestham Park.
- River Adur. The River Adur and its floodplain is of particular interest to environmental groups in the Parish, and we ask that Rampion 2 take steps to minimise any impact to this environment.
