

A representative of Twineham Parish Council wishes to attend the Issue Specific Hearing starting on Wednesday, 7th February, to participate on any discussions on the following agenda items::

- i. is concerned about the impact of construction traffic through the Parish of Twineham to the site of the connecting cable route from Oakendene to the Bolney National Grid substation, located in the Parish of Twineham, and to the site of the extension of the Bolney National Grid substation;
- ii. will be seeking to ensure that the small, rural roads around the Parish will be prohibited from use in the Construction Traffic Management Plan by everyone associated with the project, including construction workers, private workers, light vans, HGVs, etc.;
- iii. will also be requesting that deliveries via the roads in the Parish to the construction sites and compounds will be within the permitted Construction Hours for the amenity of local residents;
- iv, will be requesting that a holding area for HGV deliveries be incorporated into the Construction Traffic Management Plan to ensure that HGVs/cement vehicles do not block local roads within the Parish;
- v. will be assured that all vehicles are fitted with "white noise" reversing beepers.

Agenda Item 4 - Environmental Matters: Twineham Parish Council will wish to be part of any discussions on:

- i. the level of effect on landscape character and visual amenity in the Parish caused by the construction of the cable route within the Parish and the extension of the existing Bolney substation, particularly on any Public Rights of Way;
- ii. construction effects, particularly the proposed construction hours and the amenity of local residents, the use of generators, construction lights, the impact of horizontal direct drilling under Wineham Lane, and the construction and size of compounds in or near to the Parish.
