I would like to request an accompanied site visit from your inspectors please

As local residents living on Kent Street we are very worried about the area around Kent Street / Cratemans Farm / Cowfold stream and also the green lane from Moatfield Lane

We would request a visit in May when it is possible to see the large environmental damage this application will have on this sensitive area

We have a very rural countryside feel to this region with wildflower meadows, nightingales, fields with adders and grass snakes and badgers. This wildlife corridor will be lost for ever

The current country lanes network with soft clay verges and ditches will not be able to cope with such a large infrastructure project, the new proposed access routes across field will be water logged much of the year as we only have clay here and many farmers can only be on the land certain parts of the year, and only when we have prolonged periods without rain. New routes into the countryside will be disastrous

Please confirm if you can visit as you need to walk these routes to appreciate how rural this area is

The Rampion II submission is mostly based on desk top surveys and much of their information is not true compared to real life experiences on the ground
