**In order for the Examining Authority to full understand the impact of Rampion on the local community it is essential that they organise accompanied site inspections focusing on the following :**

- **Visit all the areas encompassing the Cratemans Farm Area, Cowfold Stream, Green Lane between Moatfield Lane and Kent Street including Kings lane, preferably in May when area is at is most beautiful. My understanding is that this has not been done fully! You are unable to get a complete picture until you visit all lanes and wild areas from top to bottom and see for yourselves the impact Rampion will have on the wild life and natural habitation**
- **Take particular attention to the local lanes which are in fact single track lanes and farm tracks and see how Rampion traffic will cause chaos with the verges being destroyed and access for residents and local suppliers significantly affected and reduced and the main haulage ways including the wildlife tracks destroyed.**
- **See what the implications will be of the traffic on homes ( included listed dwellings on these lanes, tracks including noise, pollution , curtailed access etc )**
