As requested by [REDACTED] in the Open Floor Hearing this week asking for evidence to my reference about the visible scarification of the South Downs from Rampion 1, please refer to Page 8 of the Written Representation made by South Downs National Park Authority. Page 8 includes images as evidence of scarification from Rampion 1, and Appendix B provides further details. Further to this, Shermanbury Parish Council have also made written representation to you which references how Rampion 1 construction has left severely damaged road surfaces and verges.
