

Itinerary ref: 1c Walk Moatfield/Kings Lane duration 10 minutes. I requested a visit to the Green Lane/tree boundary G35 just off Moatfield Lane. The site is just a few minutes walk off the lane. I have verbal permission of the landowners, which can also be in writing if requested although largely the access is via public footpaths. As the itinerary stands not enough time has been allowed as this site is at the second crossing of the cable construction route approximately  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile down Kings/Moatfield Lane. I would suggest that the minibus transports people to this spot (pulling up at the polo field gate) then drives back to the meeting point to walk Kent Street (ref 1b). This allows a view of both crossing points as well as well as the access issues for such a long, narrow lane with 10 properties.

Ref 2 Visit Cratemans Farm and Cowfold Stream. I requested the visit to Crateman's Farm and can help guide round the site alongside the landowner. The site visit lists the Cowfold Stream which is not very accessible from the Crateman's side but can be better understood visually from the other side across either of the two bridges. It is part of Park Farm on Kings Lane and I can obtain permission from the landowner to walk a short way on this land if required. Where the Cowfold Stream floods around the HDD crossing site is better viewed from the Moatfield farm side.
