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## 1. Viewpoint directory

#### 1.1 Introduction

This Appendix provides a complete directory of all the viewpoints used to inform the Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment (LVIA) of the onshore elements of the Proposed Development.

### 1.2 Viewpoint directory

- 1.2.1 The viewpoint directory includes:
  - Viewpoints selected for the onshore substation options, landfall and onshore cable corridor at the Scoping stage (Rampion Extension Development Limited (RED), 2020);
  - Viewpoints selected for the onshore substation options, landfall and onshore cable corridor in the Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR) (RED, 2021) published as part of the first Statutory Consultation exercise in 2021;
  - Viewpoints recommended for inclusion through the consultation process (including both non-statutory and statutory consultation);
  - Viewpoints selected for the ES related to the onshore substation at Oakendene, the existing National Grid Bolney substation extension and the landfall and onshore cable corridor; and
  - In addition some 3D wirelines have been included from locations along the onshore cable corridor\_close to the South Downs Way and within the South Downs National Park (SDNP).
- The viewpoint directory includes all those viewpoints which have been deleted / relocated and / or suggested as new or alternative viewpoint locations through the consultation, design and assessment process.
- as due diligence by the assessor and/or photographer in order to capture an optimum representative viewpoint photograph avoiding intervening features such as vegetation, buildings etc. Therefore, the final name and/or coordinates of the viewpoint location may be slightly different to that originally proposed as it has been refined but this has not been recorded. Only significant alterations to the viewpoints have been recorded in the directory that may have arisen from further assessment/investigation and/or comments during the consultation process.
- The viewpoint directory should be read in conjunction with Figures 18.2 to 18.4a-c, Volume 3 of the ES (Document Reference: 6.3.18) (updated at Deadline 4), which indicate the locations of all viewpoints included in the directory.
