We offer comment here in regard to the ExA's further written questions and requests for information:

- 1. Examining Authority's (ExA) Consultation Draft Development Consent Order schedule of changes: Question DCO 2.4 We support the amendments introduced by the Examination Authority to the draft Development Consent Order.
- 2. However, within the draft Deemed Marine Licence we draw the Examination Authorities attention to the importance of this amendment to Schedule 12 (Transmission Assets), Condition 11(2) to include West Sussex County Council as it is possible that works could occur within the intertidal area and therefore its drafting should be subject to advice from the county archaeological advice service.
