Dear Sirs

I am very concerned about Rampion's proposal to replace the Northern section of Footpath 1786 by diverting it to the boundary on the eastern perimeter of the scheme's WORKS COMPOUND. Apart from the obvious loss of public amenity in an environmental sense is the claim that the existing route will only suffer 'temporary' closure :- 5 years minimum indicated as per "Rampion Rights of Way - Sheet 33."

In conclusion I would suggest that the route diversion proposed by Rampion has not (so far as I am aware) been accompanied with any detail or explanation how the proximity to movement by HGV works vehicles and construction activity is sufficiently safe.

Other walkers in Cowfold have agreed that a public RoW should never be degraded by any collateral health risk to its users.
