1. Viewpoint directory

1.1 Introduction

This Appendix provides a complete directory of all the viewpoints used to inform the Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment (LVIA) of the onshore elements of the Proposed Development.

1.2 Viewpoint directory

- 1.2.1 The viewpoint directory includes:
 - Viewpoints selected for the onshore substation options, landfall and onshore cable corridor at the Scoping stage (Rampion Extension Development Limited (RED), 2020);
 - Viewpoints selected for the onshore substation options, landfall and onshore cable corridor in the Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR) (RED, 2021) published as part of the first Statutory Consultation exercise in 2021;
 - Viewpoints recommended for inclusion through the consultation process (including both non-statutory and statutory consultation);
 - Viewpoints selected for the ES related to the onshore substation at Oakendene, the existing National Grid Bolney substation extension and the landfall and onshore cable corridor; and
 - In addition some 3D wirelines have been included from locations along the onshore cable corridor close to the South Downs Way and within the South Downs National Park (SDNP).
- The viewpoint directory includes all those viewpoints which have been deleted / relocated and / or suggested as new or alternative viewpoint locations through the consultation, design and assessment process.
- 1.2.3 It is accepted that a certain amount of micro-siting would have taken place on site as due diligence by the assessor and/or photographer in order to capture an optimum representative viewpoint photograph avoiding intervening features such as vegetation, buildings etc. Therefore, the final name and/or coordinates of the viewpoint location may be slightly different to that originally proposed as it has been refined but this has not been recorded. Only significant alterations to the viewpoints have been recorded in the directory that may have arisen from further assessment/investigation and/or comments during the consultation process.
- The viewpoint directory should be read in conjunction with **Figures 18.2a-c** to **18.4a-e**, **Volume 3** of the ES (Document Reference: 6.3.18) (updated at Deadline 4), which indicate the locations of all viewpoints included in the directory.

Development Consent Order (DCO) Application	An application for consent to undertake a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project made to the Planning Inspectorate who will consider the application and make a recommendation to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy, who will decide on whether development consent should be granted for the Proposed Development.
Development Consent Order (DCO) Limits	The limits of the land to which the Application for the DCO relates, within which the Authorised Development must be carried out and which is required for its construction and operation, as shown on the Land Plan including Order Limits.
Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)	The process of evaluating the likely significant environmental effects of a proposed project or development over and above the existing circumstances (or 'baseline').
Environmental measures	Measures which are proposed to prevent, reduce and where possible offset any significant adverse effects (or to avoid, reduce and if possible, remedy identified effects).
Environmental Statement (ES)	The written output presenting the full findings of the Environmental Impact Assessment.
Horizontal Directional Drill (HDD)	HDD is a process whereby a tunnel is drilled under an obstacle and a cable duct is pulled through the drilled underground tunnel. It avoids the need for trenches, and enables minimal disruption to routing cables through rivers, roads, drains and other obstacles.
Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP)	Nationally Significant Infrastructure Projects (NSIP) are major infrastructure developments in England and Wales which are consented by DCO. These include proposals for offshore wind farms with an installed capacity greater than 100MW.
Preliminary Environmental Information Report (PEIR)	The written output of the Preliminary Environmental Impact Assessment undertaken for the Proposed Development. It was developed to support the first Statutory Section 42 Consultation exercise in July to September 2021. The PEIR presented the preliminary findings of the assessment to allow an informed view to be developed of the Proposed Development, the assessment approach that had been undertaken, and the preliminary conclusions on the likely significant effects of the Proposed Development and environmental measures proposed.
