STATUS

The Property is agricultural land to the east of Lyminster and south of the A27. The Applicant has engaged with the Landowner since the start of 2021 and during that time the Applicant has considered a cable route alteration at the Landowner's request to mitigate the impact of the Project on the Landowner's development aspirations demonstrating meaningful consultation and engagement.

The Preliminary Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) cable route alignment ran parallel with the railway line before turning East (just to the South of the A27) before turning North (crossing the A27) and heading towards Warningcamp. This was the Landowner's preferred cable route. The introduction of the Alternative Cable Route ("ACR-02") in October 2022 further to the first statutory consultation was met with resistance from the Landowner as this travelled through part of the landholding that the Landowner had identified for long-term residential development.

The Landowner is not willing to accept the Applicant's reasoning and justification for the selection of the ACR-02 cable route and particularly the cable route alignment as it passes through the landholding and crosses the A284 (Lyminster Road). The Landowner considers that the proposals would sterilise any development potential the Property may have, although the Applicant has subsequently been informed that opportunities for development are being explored.

In addition to the Heads of Terms for the cable route, the Applicant has updated these Heads of Terms, increasing the easement consideration offer as well as including payments for the temporary construction access and combined construction and operational access routes across the Property.

NEGOTIATIONS FOR VOLUNTARY ACQUISITION OF RIGHTS

- Heads of Terms were issued in April 2023.
- The Landowner has not responded to the Heads of Terms.
- The Applicant was informed verbally by the Landowner's agent that the easement offer made was not considered to reflect development value of the land and therefore that the Landowner was not willing to sign the **Heads of Terms**.

PROGRESS OF ENGAGEMENT FOLLOWING CAH1

- The Applicant held an on-line video TEAMS call with the Landowner's agent on **13th June 2024** to seek to establish the Landowner's position in relation to the **Heads of Terms** / likelihood of reaching a voluntary agreement. The Applicant's agent raised a number of questions relating to restrictive covenants over the permanent easement. The Applicant communicated the requirements of the restriction, however stated that a detailed assessment could be carried out in relation to any masterplans the landowner has had drawn up.
- The Landowner's agent reiterated that the Landowner does not believe the easement consideration on offer reflects the development ("hope") value of the land and continued to state concerns about the extent of the restrictions being imposed in the Deed of Easement.
- The Applicant issued the Landowner with Revised Heads of Terms, including an increased easement offer, payments for temporary construction access and combined construction and operational access on 28th June. 2024.

LANDOWNER ENGAGEMENT (2021 to 2024)

- The Applicant had detailed dialogue with the Landowner and the Landowner's agent during 2021.
- Written correspondence issued both via emails and letters have been issued to the Landowners across this
 period as evidenced by the Landowner Engagement Tracker (below).
- The Applicant's initial correspondence during **2021**, **2022** and **2023** related to drawing up and agreeing a survey access licence and arranging access for several ecological surveys.
- In an on-site meeting in **April 2022** the Landowner confirmed that the land on the western side of the A284 (Lyminster Road) was being held for long-term residential development, and that upon the completion of the Lyminster Bypass the land would be actively promoted for development.

The Landowner requested that if the cable route was to pass through this area, the cable route be moved as close to the southern field boundary as possible to seek to mitigate the potential impact on any future development of the land.

The Landowner's agent made it clear that the Applicant's easement offer was not sufficient compensation for the loss of the development value and requested that there should be a degree of negotiation over the easement consideration to reflect the development "hope" value. The Applicant noted that the land is not allocated for housing development in the local plan and is subject to a biodiversity net gain policy (See below).

IMPACT ON LAND INTEREST

- The ACR-02 cable route severs the Property effectively in half maintaining an appropriate distance from the residential properties to the North and from the Caravan Park to the South.
- The Applicant notes that the Property is not subject to any promotion or option agreement with a developer to purchase the land for residential development. The land has not been designated for residential development within the Local Plan nor is it a site that has been allocated or called forward as part of a Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment (SHLAA) by the Local Planning Authority. The Applicant notes the Landowner's land is designated as a Biodiversity Opportunity Area.

PROPOSED MITIGATION

- The Applicant can mitigate the impacts on the use of the land through agreeing accommodation works in advance of construction commencing such as crossing points.
- The Applicant has offered to consider any forthcoming masterplans to consider compatibility with the permanent cable easement

OUTSTANDING ISSUES DELAYING CONCLUSION OF VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT

- The Landowner is not willing to sign up to a voluntary agreement with the cable route running through the middle of their landholding, without the easement offer incorporating "hope" value. The Landowner has made it clear that only a cable route as close to the southern boundary of the landholding as possible is acceptable. This is notwithstanding the lack of local plan housing allocation or planning consents or positive planning appraisals for the land.
- The Landowner's agent has requested more details from the Applicant in relation to restrictions over the easement in particular with regard to gardens and bell mouth entrances. The Applicant has communicated the project cable easement restrictions and requested a masterplan to consider any bespoke solutions.
