Securing trenchless crossings underneath Irreplaceable Habitats and SSSIs - section 9

Dear Secretary of State

The area around Crateman's Farm and the local environment near Cowfold is some of the best countryside in the region, significant for its trees, hedgerows and bird life. An exceptionally good nature report about this area has already been submitted. The public footpaths provide important access for those living in Cowfold and the area.

This area, alongside many others in the UK, demands that cables for windfarms should not be at the expense of the preservation of the best of our country life, environment, ecology and habitats.

This means that trenchless crossings in the area underneath important habitats and SSSIs should be avoided at all costs, let alone the laying of cable trenches.
