Dear sir/madam,

I am a landowner (Moatfield farm, rh13 8bd) where the cable route will pass directly through our fields. I wanted to highlight my views in response to this section-

15. The Applicant should provide an update on the progression of Heads of Terms with Affected Persons in relation to the compulsory acquisition of land by voluntary means, and to submit an updated Land Rights Tracker."

We haven't signed heads of terms on principle given there is no offer of compensation due to disturbance and loss of value if we wanted to sell for the multi year period the works will occupy the field. Engagement by rampion has been relatively poor and the compensation offered is only a limited uplift over standard wayleave payments plus economic loss of use (relocation of horse grazing areas) but no inconvenience compensation.
