Boreham Conservation Society:

Please can the Boreham Conservation Society provide a response to Question 2.7.1. of **The Examining Authority's Further Written Questions and Requests for Information (ExQ2)** issued on **Tuesday 18 October 2022**.

ExQ2.7.1: The ExA notes that Boreham Conservation Society refers to two listed buildings which overlook the Solar Farm Site, the setting of which it considers would be compromised by the proposal. Please can Boreham Conservation Society specify the buildings being referred to.

A response to ExQ2.7.1 should be provided, at or before **Deadline 6 on Thursday 15 December 2022**.

Environment Agency:

Please can the Environment Agency provide a response to Question 2.11.1. of **The Examining Authority's Further Written Questions and Requests for Information (ExQ2)** issued on **Tuesday 18 October 2022**.

ExQ2.11.1: Can the EA confirm whether or not it agrees that the Water Framework Directive (WFD) information provided in the application appropriately demonstrates the Proposed Development's compliance with the requirements of the WFD?

A response to ExQ2.7.1 should be provided, at or before **Deadline 6 on Thursday 15 December 2022**.

UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA)/Office for Health Improvement and Disparities (OHID):

In paragraph 4.4.1. of the Statement of Commonality Revision 4.0 [REP4-030/REP4-031] forming part of the Applicant's submission made at **Deadline 4 on Thursday 3 November 2022**; reference is made to correspondence sent by the UKHSA to the ExA on 15 September 2022 confirming that they are satisfied with the health assessment. Please can the UKHSA/OHID submit this correspondence into the Examination at or before **Deadline 6 on Thursday 15 December 2022**.

Alternatively, if not submitted by the UKHSA, can the correspondence referred to above be submitted by the Applicant, Longfield Solar Energy Farm Limited, at or before **Deadline 6 on Thursday 15 December 2022** or an updated Statement of Common Ground reflecting the position with respect to this Statement of Common Ground between Longfield Solar Energy Farm Limited and the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA)/Office for Health Improvement and Disparities (OHID).

Responses should be submitted by at or before **Deadline 6 (Thursday 15 December 2022)**.

Other Interested Parties may also wish to respond to this request.
