Request for further information

I am writing under Rule 17 of the Infrastructure Planning (Examination Procedure) Rules 2010 (as amended) to request the following information:

ES Chapter 8 (Ecology) [APP-040] and ES Chapter 5 (EIA Methodology) [APP-037] confirm that the ecological assessment is based on the Concept Design. Table 5-1 of ES Chapter 5 states (in relation to the ecological assessment) that "The Concept Design does not have a smaller footprint than the Design Principles, and therefore the conclusions of the assessment are not affected by the flexibility allowed by the Design Principles".

However, in the case of Work No.4 (grid connection route), the cable trench is defined in the Concept Design [REP6-005] as being 1900mm, whilst in the Outline Design Principles [REP6-007] it is stated as up to 3m wide. ES Chapter 8 (paragraph 8.3.4, a-d) does not specifically refer to the cable route in justifying why construction of the Proposed Development would not result in a greater impact to ecological receptors than the Concept Design. Please explain how this is accounted for in the ecological assessment and why this could not result in a greater adverse impact than what has been assessed.

I am also mindful that the same point applies in relation to the Landscape and Visual Impact Assessment (ES Chapter 10, paragraph 10.3.1 refers) [REP1b-005].

On the basis of the above, I am considering whether provisions should be included in the dDCO to restrict the cable trench width parameter to what has been assessed in the ES. The Applicant is invited to comment.



Responses should be submitted on or before **Deadline 8** (**Wednesday 18 January 2023**). The Applicant may, however, wish to provide an interim response at Deadline 7 (**Wednesday 11 January 2023**).
