Thank you for your email.

As Essex County Council (C Authority), Braintree District Council (B Authority) and Chelmsford City Council (B Authority) are host authorities for the Longfield Solar Farm application, under section 102(1)(c) of the Planning Act 2008, they are automatically Interested Parties for the duration of the examination and therefore do not need to register. However, it is advised that host authorities take a more proactive approach and submit a relevant representation. This will allow their views to be considered by the Examining Authority (ExA) when it carries out its initial assessment of principal issues in advance of the preparation of the draft examination timetable, which is included in the ExA's invitation to the Preliminary Meeting (Rule 6 letter).
