 With reference to the above and following the receipt of the advice provided under section 51 of the Planning Act 2008 ('PA 2008'), including the section 55 checklist, following the Secretary of State's decision to accept the application ('the Application') from Drax Power Limited ('the Applicant') for a Development Consent Order ('DCO') on 20 June 2022, we write to provide a response to the advice.

- 3. In addition, the Applicant will ensure that the North York Moors National Park Authority and the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority are consulted as 'D' authorities only (rather than 'A' and 'D' authorities as previously consulted for the s42 consultation).
- 4. For all future publicity required regarding this Application, the Applicant confirms that it will ensure that publicity material will invite recipients to request consultation information in other languages or formats, should this be required to facilitate access to documents.

5. The Applicant notes the advice to ensure consultation with all Category 3 Affected Persons identified in the Book of Reference ((Document 4.3) as identified in Box 10 of the section 55 checklist, and will serve notice of the accepted application under section 56(2)(d) of the PA2008 to all Affected Persons.

Plans

6. In response to the section 51 advice, the Applicant has updated the Works Plans (document reference 2.3, Rev P02, July 2022) and the Indicative Plans and Elevations (document reference 2.5, Rev P02, July 2022) to show the direction of North on each sheet, and ensure sheet numbers are included , where appropriate. The Applicant confirms that there was no necessity to update the Plans to refer to limits of deviation for each numbered work, and the Draft DCO (document reference 3.1, Rev 02, July 2022) has been updated accordingly.
